

ANNUAL INSPECTION OF OLD SOMERBY PARISH COUNCIL ASSETS

Report to the Parish Council Meeting 28 October 2024.

On 8 October, 2024 Cllr Stephens and the Clerk David Holmes undertook an inspection of the Parish Councils Assets:

Bus Shelter – refurbished 2021 and appeared in good order. A Volunteer who lives nearby keeps the inside area clean and tidy which is much appreciated.

Road Side Seats – Millennium Seat and bench on School Lane. The Millennium Seat is in need of a wash down which **Cllr Stephens undertook to was down**. The Millennium Seat was in good order.

Defibrillator – Inspected by the clerk and in good order.

3 Dog Bins – In good order and regularly used. The services of the volunteers are much appreciated. **SUPPLY OF NEW BAGS TO EACH VOLUNTEER - DONE**

3 Notice Boards – 1) The Notice Board on the Main Road is now in need of being refurbished **ACTION**: The Clerk to seek the services of a volunteer.* 2) The one on School Lane is in good order. 3). The Notice Board in the Bus Shelter is also in good order. The area of concrete outside the Bus Shelter has cracked. The work is shortly to be undertaken as previously agreed. *** BLL GROCOCK TO BE ASKED**

30 mph Speed Indication Signs – Some signs need cleaning and repositioning and one needs to be replaced. **10 new signs in hand to replace existing**

Two Troughs - the one on Main Road towards the Roundabout is regularly visited by the clerk and is in good order. The other one located on Main Road near exit to Bourne has been visited by the clerk recently and is also in good order. Both looked after by volunteers.

Active Speed Indicator: The indicator on the Main Road was in place during the inspection and it was in good working order. The services of the Volunteer are much appreciated.

Solar Speed Indicator: It has now been in use for 2 years and seems very effective in slowing down traffic. It was in good order upon inspection.
